Each 5-day motif will show 5 days of temperatures. Each 4-day motif will show 4 days of temperatures.

You can use 1 motif for all or two different motifs, or some other configuration.

Measurement possibilities without borders: 6" squares = 54" x 54" blanket, 7" squares = 63" x 63" blanket, 8" squares = 72" x 72" blanket, 9" squares = 81" x 81" blanket, 10" squares = 90" x 90" blanket (and probably a good size for a queen size bed).

You don't have to have a certain number of rows in the motifs, just make sure you include the 5 colors for the 5 days in order, or the 4 days in order, and it should still show the variation in temperatures. So, if the motif has 14 rounds in it, you could double up some rows, or even triple some row colors, and do singles of others. This might also be good for doing a mixed motif blanket as well.
